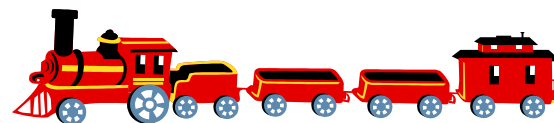

### **Cub Scout Leader Specific Training (CLS) - Classroom**

Effective 10/1/2008, Cub Leader Specific is broken down into 3 parts:

Part I - II : Intro to Scouting, How We Have Fun - Only need to be taken once  
Part III - Must be taken for EACH position held (as well as the Fast Start)

MUST take all 3 parts to "complete" CLS Training

### **New IOLS Courses**

IOLS Challenge - designed predominately to Eagle and other Scouters who already know how to teach outdoor skills to demonstrate such. Can earn IOLS Certification

IOLS Refresher - designed for Leaders to brush up on Outdoor skills. Does NOT earn IOLS Certification

### **What Makes a Trained Leader?**

- Cub Scout leaders** are considered trained when they have completed Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This Is Scouting, and the Cub Scout Position-Specific training for their registered position.
- Scoutmasters and assistant Scoutmasters** are considered trained when they have completed Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This Is Scouting, Scoutmaster and Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training, and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- Troop committee members** are considered trained when they have completed Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This Is Scouting, and the Troop Committee Challenge as their Leader Specific training.
- Varsity Scout coaches and assistants** are considered trained when they have completed Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This Is Scouting, Varsity Scout Leader Specific Training, and Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills.
- Varsity committee members** are considered trained when they have completed Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This Is Scouting, Varsity Scout Leader Specific Training, and Troop Committee Challenge.
- Venturing crew Advisors, associate Advisors, skippers, mates, and crew/ship committee members** are considered trained when they have completed Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training (included in Venturing Leader Specific), This Is Scouting, and Venturing Leader Specific Training.
- ScoutParent Unit Coordinators** are considered trained when they complete ScoutParent Unit Coordinator Fast Start Training, Youth Protection Training, This Is Scouting, and the appropriate committee training for their program area
